## Mercedes Benz Corporate Run

Please note the following race schedule, but keep in mind that the Police will close off streets as necessary to keep everyone safe!

**2:00pm** Street Closures and Detours start. Northbound lanes of Biscayne Blvd., from Chopin Plaza to NE 5 ST will close. The Southbound lanes will offer two-way traffic and special attention will be given to entry and exit of Chopin Plaza (Hotel Intercontinental and One Miami).

**4:00pm** The first of 20,000 Participants start arriving.

**6:00pm** Northbound Brickell Ave traffic will be sent West on SE 7 ST. Only traffic going to Hotel Intercontinental and
